Winter (Oct—April): Tues thru Sat, 8 am to 5 pm
 (Fort buildings are locked up for the season)

Admission prices* are \$4 for adults; \$3 for youths & seniors; free for kids 12 & under.

*Note: Admission prices are half price when fort is locked during the winter.
